

Brighton Michigan Garden Club Scholarship

The Brighton Michigan Garden Club is pleased to offer a \$1,500 scholarship to a Brighton Area Schools High School Senior who is pursuing an environmental science related field of study.

Qualifications:

- 3.0 GPA or higher
- Proposed field of study must be in the field of Environmental Science: including Horticulture, Landscape Design, Botany, Biology, Forestry, Ecology, Environmental Engineering, Land Management, and/or other related or allied subjects.
- Applicant must write a one page essay detailing interest, activities and career goals related to the chosen field of study.

Application Procedure:

- Fill out the application form
- Write the essay requested above
- Include one letter of recommendation from High School Staff Member
- Obtain high school transcript

Completed applications are due by Monday, April 27, 2026 in your High School Counselor's Office.

Selection Criteria:

Applications are evaluated and the winner chosen by the Brighton Michigan Garden Club Scholarship committee. If no applicant is considered acceptable, the scholarship will be retained by the Brighton Michigan Garden Club.

The following scale of points will be used for the evaluation of each application:

- Academic record 40%
- Applicant's essay 30%
- Listing of honors/ extracurricular activities/ work experience 20%
- Recommendation letter 10%

The award is not limited to any specific accredited college or technical school. The \$1,500 Scholarship will be payable to the recipient's university or college.
